DAY 1: MAY 4 CAPE TOWN

DAY 2: MAY 5 CAPE TOWN

TAJ CAPE TOWN

DAY 3: MAY 6 CAPE TOWN

Start your day with a scenic drive to the Cape Winelands, a region renowned for its breathtaking landscapes and world-class wines. Marvel at the scenic views, stroll through Stellenbosch, with its charming Cape Dutch architecture. Enjoy wine tastings at two premium wineries, a cellar tour, and a delicious lunch in Franschhoek, the gourmet capital of the Cape. (BL)

DAY 4: MAY 7 CAPE TOWN

KRUGER PRIVATE RESERVE

Wake up to the sounds of the African bush and set off on an early morning game drive, exploring the vast wilderness surrounding Kapama River Lodge. With an expert guide and tracker, venture through the reserve in search of the Big Five and other incredible wildlife as the sun rises over the savanna. After an exhilarating morning, return to the lodge for a hearty breakfast and spend the midday hours at leisure—relax by the pool, indulge in a spa treatment, or soak in the natural beauty from your suite. In the late afternoon, embark on a second game drive, where the cooler temperatures bring out a different side of the bush, increasing the chances of spotting elusive predators. As the sun sets, enjoy a sundowner in the wild before returning to the lodge for a delicious dinner under the stars. (BLD)

DAY 7: MAY 10

KRUGER PRIVATE RESERVE

Another day of adventure awaits at Kapama River Lodge, set within the breathtaking Kapama Private Reserve. Begin with an early morning game drive, venturing into the wild as the sun



rises, offering prime opportunities to spot the Big Five and other incredible wildlife. DAY 8: MAY 11

KRUGER PRIVATE RESERVE

Kapama is the largest owner-managed private game reserve in the area, encompassing 13,000 hectares of sweeping wilderness. The reserve is also one of Africa's premier ecotourism destinations. (BLD)

DAY 9: MAY 12

KRUGER PRIVATE RESERVE / VICTORIA FALLS. ZIMBABWE

Take a short bush flight to Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport and connect to your flight to Victoria Falls. Upon arrival, you'll be escorted to your luxury accommodations for a three-night stay. This afternoon, enjoy a sunset cruise on the Zambezi River, where you can spot hippos playing in the water and elephants coming to the riverbank for their last drink before nightfall. (BLD)

VICTORIA FALLS / DEPART


